(This is an alphabetized list of 1774 tithables found at http://www.newrivernotes.com/surry_enumerations_1774_tax_list.htm. The list on the website purports to be a transcription of the original tax list of that year. I have alphabetized the original tax list to make individual searches easier to accomplish. I have used the exact spelling of each name as found on the website. Where more than one person appears to have been in the same household, I have so indicated with the wording "listed with." The persons underlined in the list below were additionally noted on the website to have been on the accounts of the North Carolina Revolutionary Army. The persons designed "Negro" in the original list were apparently slaves. There were apparently 14 of 51 households with slaves. They are appended to the alphabetized list. Additionally, since many original lists were often compiled as the enumerator went from farmhouse to farmhouse, a researcher can often learn about close neighbors by viewing the original non-alphabetized list.)
